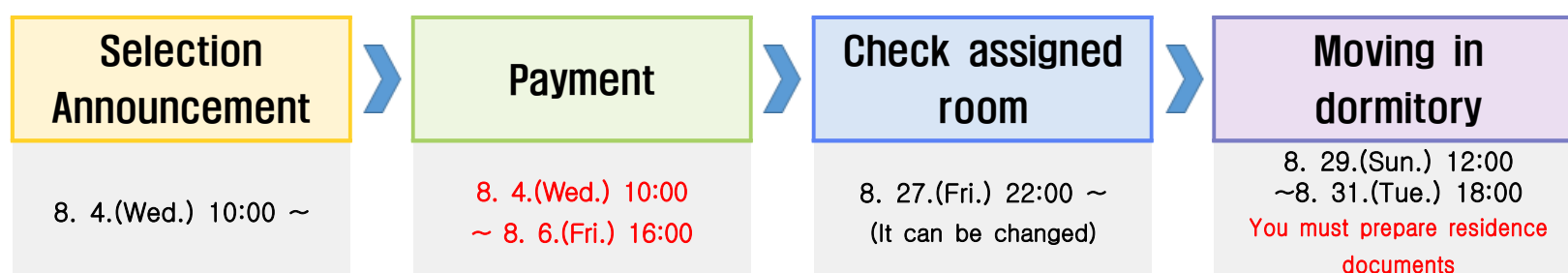


# 2021 Fall semester Dormitory Announcement of opening and payment for International Students

The dormitory for 2021 Fall Semester will be opened, and the operation of the dormitory **can be changed or reduced (schedule, change of room, closure, etc.)** depending on the COVID-19 situation.

Please be sure to read and apply for the notice, and we inform you that you are fully responsible for any disadvantages caused by the failure of understanding this notice.



## 1. Guide for 2021 Fall Semester International Students Dormitory Opening

(1) Opening period: 2021. 8. 29.(Sun.) 12:00~12. 21.(Tue.) 12:00 (115days)

[Myungyui-gwan] 2021. 8. 29.(Sun.) 12:00~1. 15.(Sat.) 12:00 (140days)

As the new construction of the dormitory (including the demolition of the existing building) is underway from the 2021 Fall semester, **many inconveniences** such as noise, dust, vibration, and traffic inconvenience are expected **around the Sungsil-Bongsa-Jinli-Hwamok-gwan.**

(2) Cafeteria: 2021. 8. 29.(Sun.) Dinner~12. 21.(Tue.) Breakfast, only for Cheomseong-gwan.

※ The operation of cafeteria can be changed depending on the COVID-19 situation.

(3) Subject: Among the international students selected for 2021 Fall Semester dormitory, those who do not fall under the following residency restrictions

- a) Selection: 2021. 8. 4.(Wed.) 10:00~, YES system
- b) Room Assignment: 2021. 8. 27.(Fri.) 22:00, YES system

(4) Restrictions for Application: If one or more of the following restrictions, students are not allowed to move in even if they are confirmed to have passed the dormitory.

Selection will be canceled if documents are deemed unfit when moving in, and living expenses paid will be refunded in accordance with the refund policy.

- a) Those who are not enrolled in the Fall semester of 2021.
- b) Those who subject to disciplinary action from dormitory(including those who have acquired 7 or more penalty points, and those who were forced to leave dormitory in 2020)
- c) Infectious disease patients and carriers.
- d) Others: Restrictions on occupancy may be added depending on circumstances such as COVID-19.

## (5) Instructions

- a) As the new construction of the dormitory (including the demolition of the existing building) is underway

from the 2021 Fall semester, **many inconveniences** such as **noise, dust, vibration, and traffic inconvenience** are expected around the Sungsil·Bongsa·Jinli·Hwamok-gwan.

- b) From the 2021 Fall semester, the facilities cannot be used as the Geungji, Hyupdong-gwan will be demolished.
- c) Hyupdong-gwan parcel storage room is unavailable from 7.17 (Sat) due to the demolition. A temporary parcel storage room will be installed in front of Jinli-gwan around the end of August.
- d) Due to the new construction of the dormitory, **there is a risk of safety accidents** caused by various construction vehicles and heavy construction equipment, so **prohibit access to construction sites and refrain from passing nearby.**
- e) A simple cooking facility will be installed inside the Sungsil·Bongsa·Jinli·Hwamok-gwan dormitory building.
- f) **Adjustment of the opening schedule (postponement, extension, reduction, etc.), change of dormitory, or movement of dormitory may occur arbitrarily** at any time depending on COVID-19 and other circumstances, and **students must cooperate with this.**
- g) Up to two-person rooms are operated to prevent COVID-19 and proliferation.

## 2. Guidance on the resistration(payment) of living expenses

(1) **Subject:** All international students who are selected for 2021 Fall semester dormitory

(2) **Resistration(Payment) period**

a) 2021. 8. 4.(Wed.) 10:00~8. 6.(Fri.) 16:00

※ If you cannot pay within the period of payment due to your return during vacation, you must submit 'Statement of Reasons' and 'plane e-ticket(confirmation)' to the dormitory administration office before you leave(registration period).

b) Those who have submitted a "Statement of Reasons" in advance: **Return ~ 2021. 9. 3.(Fri.) 16:00**

※ **Even if you pay in the extended period, you should check the select number of meals and print residence bill in advance.**

※ **If you don't send the statement of reason and pay the bill, your selection will be automatically cancelled. (No additional payment)**

(3) **Dormitory Fee(2021. Fall semester)**

- No cafeteria in Hwamok-gwan and Myungyui-gwan.
- Eligibility: Cheomseong-gwan residents.
- You can't change your meal type after payment.
- Meal tickets purchased individually from the meal ticket vending machine can only be used for the 2021 school year (until the end of February 2022)
- ※ Depending on COVID-19 or other circumstances, cafeteria can be suspended. In order to prevent any disadvantage in refund of food expenses due to suspension of operation, we recommend having meals according to the selected meal plan.

(4) How to register(pay) ※Use only [Internet Explorer](#).

- a) Print residence bill: – YES system log-in → Dormitory → Apply for residence → Check application status → Select number of meals → Save → Print residence bill[Printout period: [2021. 8. 4.\(Wed.\) 10:00~8. 6.\(Fri.\) 16:00](#)]
- b) Payment confirmation: You can check on the YES system(<http://yes.knu.ac.kr>)

(5) Refund

- a) For refund, you need [your own Korean account number](#).
- b) Before opening date: If you apply cancel residence application in YES 통합정보시스템 a day before opening date, you can get a full refund.
- c) After opening date: If you apply cancel residence application in YES 통합정보시스템 after opening date, you can get a refund in accordance with the refund policy.

### 3. Procedure of move-in for 2021 Fall Semester

- (1) Move-in date: [2021. 8. 29.\(Sun.\) 12:00~18:00](#), [8. 30.\(Mon.\)~8. 31.\(Tue.\) 09:00~18:00](#) [3 days]

※ The residents [must move in within the designated move-in period](#) to prevent COVID-19 and proliferation, and if you are unable to move in within the move-in period, you must submit “[Late move-in request form](#)” in advance to the dormitory email([housing@knu.ac.kr](mailto:housing@knu.ac.kr)) until [8. 25.\(Wed\)](#). Refer to the attached files.

- (2) **Required Documents:** Those who **fail to submit documents** are **not allowed to move in** without exception.

- a) **Chest X-ray examination report 1**(check for tuberculosis)
  - Effective from the one published within two months from the expected date of move-in.
  - **Original copy and it should be in only Korean or English.**
- ※ However, among new residents of the 2021 Summer vacation, those who remain in the 2021 Fall semester do not need to submit it.
- b) **Health declaration form, Residence consent form** ※ Refer to the attached files.
  - It must be completed on the move-in date.
- c) **Passport(or immigration certificate)** ※ Current residents don't need to submit.
  - Those who enter the Korea less than 15 days from abroad cannot move in.
- d) **COVID-19 Test Confirmation 1.** ※ Current residents don't need to submit.
  - Students who move in from Seoul, Incheon, Gyeonggi, and areas with a level 2 or higher distance must submit test results(negative) evidence(document or text notification) to be able to move in. After the test at the local public health center(screening clinic, designated hospital, etc.), the test result(negative) must be confirmed at the reception desk.
- e) **Additional documents** can be required to be submitted because of COVID-19 and other circumstances, you should update your information in YES system.

- (3) **Move-in procedure:** If you **do not wear a mask, you are not allowed to enter** the dormitory. **No access for outsider.** ※ **Unable to move in if the body temperature is greater than 37.5 degrees Celsius.**

- a) **Hwamok-gwan:** On 1F of the Hwamokgwan.
- b) **Cheomsung-gwan:** On B1F cafeteria or 1dong 2F of the Cheomsung-gwan.

※ [The move-in procedure can be changed](#) depending on the COVID-19 situation, and if it changes, [it will be notified on the website of the dormitory.](#)

(4) Cancellation of residence

- a) Before opening date: If you apply cancel residence application in YES 통합정보시스템 a day before opening date, you can get a full refund.
  - b) After opening date: If you apply cancel residence application in YES 통합정보시스템 after opening date, you can get a refund in accordance with the refund policy.
- ※ [For refund, you need your own Korean account number.](#)

#### 4. Cautions and other guidance

- (1) All residents have to be familiar with and comply with the rules of dormitory at KNU.
- (2) All residents must comply with quarantine measures, personal quarantine rules(Wearing an mask indoor, washing hands, keeping distance, etc.), checking for fever(once a day, If you don't do that three times, you are forced moving out), and restrictions on staying out(exception when submitting an application for a staying out, if you stay out twice without application for it, you are forced moving out).
- (3) Only those who have entered the country 14 days after their arrival are allowed to move in (submit notice of self-isolation cancellation)
- (4) If additional documents are required after moving in the dormitory, you must cooperate.
- (5) Graduate, undergraduates, and international students may be assigned together, and it is not allowed to enter other dormitory or rooms.
- (6) If there is a reason for academic change (a leave of absence, graduation, etc.) you must voluntarily leave the dormitory immediately, and if caught, you will be forced to leave the hospital.
- (7) Please update your personal information(email address, contact information, etc.) immediately so that you can get emergency notice for dormitory.
- (8) There is not enough space in the delivery room, so please cooperate so that you can receive the delivery. The administration office doesn't receive students' delivery.
- (9) Use of public facilities is restricted. example) Physical fitness room, reading room, PC room, etc.
- (10) COVID-19 and other circumstances may cause arbitrary adjustment of the opening schedule of dormitory(delay, extension, reduction, etc.) or change of the room at any time, and the students must cooperate with it.
- (11) Depending on the COVID-19 situation, self-isolation in some dormitories may occur.
- (12) As the new construction of the dormitory (including the demolition of the existing building) is underway from the 2021 Fall semester, many inconveniences such as noise, dust, vibration, and traffic inconvenience are expected around the Sungsil·Bongsa·Jinli·Hwamok-gwan.
